Royal Caribbean reserves the right to impose a fuel supplement. Pricing also includes all pre-paid gratuities, allowing us to have round robin seating at dinner each evening. Your price also includes our exclusive Good Life Welcome Cocktail Reception, and a Private Wine Tasting event to be conducted by Guy Bower and the Cellar Master of the Adventure of the Seas. Above and Beyond Travel will provide travel and tour assistance before, during and after the cruise.



For those who may wish to travel to San Juan one day prior, on February 18, we are offering a pre-night air/hotel package including group escorted air flights from Wichita on American Airlines via Dallas/Ft. Worth with one night deluxe hotel accommodations in San Juan, airport to hotel transfers and ship to airport transfers, all taxes and resort fees. This is sold as an air and hotel package only. Space for the pre-night is limited to 48 persons.

We are happy to quote individual flights to San Juan based on your schedule or your departure city. It is strongly suggested to fly to San Juan the day before the cruise in case of February weather delays. A few additional rooms are available at our group hotel for February 18. Itinerary and Ports of Call



February 18, Saturday: Pre-cruise day in San Juan, Puerto Rico. Depart Wichita to San Juan today to ensure you make the ship. Hotel accommodations at the Conrad Condado Hotel & Casino and flights on American Airlines are available at a reduced rate. Enjoy an evening in Old San Juan or Condado. Sign up today - offer limited to 48 persons.

February 19, Sunday: **San Juan Puerto Rico** For those who arrive on Saturday, your day is free to explore Old San Juan and all its charms. Board the ship at your leisure. **We depart San Juan at 8:30pm.** Join the Good Life Cruise Group for dinner in the main dining room with our group all seated together.



February 20, Monday: **Charlotte Amalie, St. Thomas** Join us tonight for an exclusive Good Life Cruise Welcome Cocktail/Wine Reception hosted by Guy and Beth Bower, Charlotte and Kim Hackett. Followed by dinner. Today find out why St. Thomas is called the "duty-free shopping capital of the world." Shop for duty-free trinkets and bargains on everything from liquor to imported china and crystal. Pricing, Deposits and Payments

The Good Life Cruise is offered exclusively by Above and Beyond Travel, Charlotte Hackett, owner. Rates are guaranteed until September 1, 2011. Space is limited to 88 participants (44 cabins). Air flights on February 18, with the hotel package and transfers are limited to 48 participants. Guests are welcome to book their own air flights, but with winter weather it is recommended to fly to San Juan at least one day prior to the cruise.

Sign up by July 1, 2011 for only a \$50.00 per cabin deposit. To pre-select your cabin assignment an additional \$450.00 per cabin deposit is required. This is advisable if you wish to have cabins close together for your group of friends. The full deposit of \$500.00 per cabin is due by September 1, 2011. Cruise deposits are fully refundable until September 1, 2011. Final payment for the cruise will be due November 25, 2011.

Pricing:

Price is based on per person cruise accommodations (double occupancy), all port fees, government taxes and fees, pre paid gratuities, Welcome Cocktail Reception, Private Wine Tasting event, Above and Beyond tour escort and travel document packet. Royal Caribbean reserves the right to impose a fuel supplement. Not included: Beverages (alcoholic and non-alcoholic) except as indicated, shore excursions, and insurance.

Pre Cruise Air/Hotel Package:

Depart the day prior to the cruise on American Airlines to San Juan via Dallas/Ft. Worth on February 18. Hotel accommodations at the Conrad Condado Plaza Hotel and Casino located in the trendy Condado neighborhood just 5 minutes taxi from Old San Juan. Price includes group air fare from Wichita to San Juan, PR via Dallas, one night deluxe accommodations including all taxes and resort fees, airport to hotel transfers and ship to airport transfers. Not included: taxi fare to the Pier allowing you to board the ship at your leisure (Approx \$15.00). Space is limited to 48 persons due to limited air flights to San Juan from Wichita. **Package Price: \$1100.00 per person.**

For those who wish to book their own air flight, but still arrive one day early we have a limited number of Hotel Only packages for \$300.00 per room including taxes and resort fees. No transfers are included. Rooms must be booked through Above and Beyond Travel, not directly with the hotel to secure this rate. Note: Most hotels in Puerto Rico have a two night minimum in the winter, so it may be difficult to find hotel accommodations elsewhere.

The initial deposit of \$50.00 is payable by cash or check to Above and Beyond Travel. All other payments may be made by cash, check or all credit cards.
